

Annual Document for Royal DSM N.V. (DSM)

Article 5:25f of the Dutch Act on Financial Supervision (Wet op het financieel toezicht, the “Wft”) stipulates that companies whose securities are admitted for trading on a regulated market situated in the Netherlands shall at least once a year make a document available to the public that provides information on what they have published or made available to the public over the preceding twelve months.

This Annual Document has been filed with the Netherlands Authority for the Financial Markets (Autoriteit Financiële Markten).
